



How to Submit an IECC New Standard

Deadline: December 9, 2024

This informational page explains the necessary steps for proposing new standards for inclusion in the International Energy Conservation Code and Chapter 11 International Residential Code. In accordance with ICC’s Code Development Procedures, Council Policy 28, proponents must provide the ICC with two copies of each proposed new standard on or before **December 9, 2024**. Failure to provide a standard copy by the deadline will result in the public comment proposal being ruled as incomplete and the public comment proposal **will not** be processed.

A. ICC STAFF REVIEW OF STANDARD COPY (Required)

Submit an authorized copy of the proposed standard to the ICC by ONE of the following methods:

- Upload the proposed standard via energy.cdpACCESS® with your public comment proposal
- Mail one hard copy of the standard to the ICC Central Regional Office, Attn: Codes and Standards Department, International Code Council, 4051 Flossmoor Road, Country Club Hills, IL 60478
- Email an authorized copy (electronic) of the standard separately to refstandards@iccsafe.org
- Email a hard copy with all necessary information, passwords, etc. to refstandards@iccsafe.org
- Email a website link to view on-line standard (a standard that is not submitted to the ICC via the CDO) to refstandards@iccsafe.org
